

Stoneybrook Hot Lunch Program 2013-14

Volunteer Guidelines;

- Please arrive by 11:35 am. Collect your classroom bin front the front foyer. We ask that you DO NOT TAKE THE BIN UNTIL ALL FOOD AS BEEN ALLOCATED TO YOUR CLASS. If you are unable to fulfil your volunteer commitment, please do your best to let us know as soon as possible, at <u>hotlunch@stoneybrookpsc.ca</u>.
- 2. Teachers will remain in the classroom/quad and are responsible for overall classroom supervision. If this does not occur, please let the Hot Lunch Coordinator know at the end of lunch.
- 3. Students *must* be given the type of food that is specified on the form. Absolutely, <u>NO SUBSTITUTIONS</u> are permitted. If the student does not want the food ordered, encourage them to communicate this message to their parents, and have them place non-perishable food in their backpack to go home. If a child feels that there should be an order and there is not, communicate this message immediately to the hot lunch team. *Do not give any food to the student.*
- 4. Make a note on the classroom list if there are any issues that require attention. *Remember, the orders are now place by the parents themselves and we have no authority to change them.* Missing order forms and manual errors are a thing of the past however, the occasional input error by a parent may occur from time to time.
- 5. We kindly ask that you consider proper food handling procedures and hand washing prior to serving lunch. Gloves will be provided for handling open food such as pizza and cookies.
- 6. Be sure to leave the classroom tidy, and remove any garbage associated with hot lunch.
- 7. Please place the class list, and any extra food and supplies in the bin and return to the front lobby.
