Key Program Facts:

- The ESMP is now celebrating its 26th year in Ontario
- More than 3,000 volunteers help run the Milk Program every school year
- Over 70% of the elementary schools in Ontario have registered
- The ESMP makes fresh, cold milk available to almost 1 million students every day.
- 100% of the proceeds are used directly in support of incidental student needs during the current school year.

A reminder that payment is due at time of order and can be made directly on-line by clicking the 'Pay Now' button at the bottom of the 'Student Orders' page. Please note that it is not necessary that you have a PayPal account to pay online by credit card.

Should you prefer to submit a cheque directly to the school, we ask that you input your order online and print out a 'Remittance Form'. Then send it to school, along with a single cheque for all students payable to Stoneybrook PSC, in a sealed envelope. Any unpaid orders will be automatically deleted from the system.
